Podcast (50 points)

What do I need to do?

Create a podcast episode in Adobe Audition advising students on what to do and not to do to learn programming.

Part 1 (25 points)

In this part you will create the content of the Podcast.

1. Explore podcasts in programming for beginners. Listen to a few podcasts and notice what you like and what you don't like.
2. Select one of the following topics:
 - a. What I wish I had known at the beginning of the semester.
 - b. What you should do to be successful in a programming course for beginners.
 - c. What you should not do to be successful in a programming course for beginners.
3. Create your script.
 - a. 12-point, arial or times roman, 1-inch margins, double-spaced.
 - b. The length should be enough to speak for 3 minutes (no more than 5). The final podcast will be longer to add the introduction, transitions, effects, and credits.
4. Must be your own original work. It should be a reflection on your own experience. This is not a wish list of what you would like the course to be. It is a podcast to advise other students on things that can help them succeed. Think about the type of advice you wish you had received at the beginning of the semester.
5. Save your work as pdf and submit.
