

**Overview**

Follow the instructions below to enroll in the tuition and fees installment payment plan. A \$35 fee will be added to the overall balance when you opt-in to this plan.

1. Go to <https://one.SJSU.edu>



2. Select the MySJSU application (type in the search bar if necessary)
3. Log in using your SJSU ID number and password (the [DUO app](#) is required)
