


AEROSPACE STUDIES

WHAT IS AIR FORCE ROTC?

Air Force ROTC is a college program offered at more than **1,100 colleges and universities** across the U.S. It prepares you to become an Air or Space Force Officer while earning a college degree. But more than that—it's a challenge, a head start on a lifetime of success, within the Department Air Force and in everything you choose to do.

In the program, you'll make the most of your college experience. You'll hone your **time-management skills, analytical skills and physical fitness**. It'll be a challenging process, but the rewards will last a lifetime.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

To become a Commissioned Officer in the Department of the Air Force, students must complete the 3 or 4 year in the AFROTC program while earning your college degree.

GENERAL MILITARY COURSE

The first section of Air Force ROTC, the General Military Course, is a two-year program offered to freshmen and sophomores.

- ◇ 1 unit academic course & 2 hour Leadership Laboratory a week
- ◇ 2 physical training sessions a week
- ◇ Opportunity to try out the program with **no** obligation

FIELD TRAINING

During the summer of their sophomore and junior year, cadets will be sent to Field Training at Maxwell AFB, AL for officer training. This training typically lasts 14 days.

Professional Officer Course

This is the final section of Air Force ROTC, for juniors and seniors who have successfully completed Field Training.

- ◇ 3 unit academic course & 2 hour Leadership Laboratory a week
- ◇ 2 physical training sessions a week
- ◇ Monthly stipends
- ◇ Preparation for Active Duty
- ◇ Career selection

COMMISSIONING

After completing the AFROTC program and graduating from a university/ college, you will commission as a Second Lieutenant in the Air or Space Force.
