

Terms and Conditions of SJSU Online Transfer Admission | Fall 2023

Provisional Admission

This offer of provisional admission is based on the academic information you reported on your Cal State Apply application and related application materials. All of your academic information must be verified before you will be allowed to enroll and register for classes at SJSU Online. Your admission will remain "provisional" until your official, final transcript(s) passes verification.

This offer of provisional admission to the academic plan (major) listed on your admission letter is only valid for this term and may not be deferred to another semester. You must enroll in at least one course during the Fall 2023 semester to maintain your admission. To ensure your enrollment and attendance at SJSU Online, all of the mandatory steps below must be completed.

Returning SJSU Students: All returning SJSU students must comply with all deadlines and admission requirements included in this document.

Mandatory Steps to Enrollment

You must meet all deadlines and conditions of your admission.

■ Meet Immunization/Vaccination Requirements

Meet immunization and vaccination requirements, which can be found at sjsu.edu/medical/services/immunizations.php and sjsu.edu/medical/services/covid-vaccine

Please note that even if you are fully remote and do not intend to access any campus resources in person, you will need to sign in to MySJSU (one.sjsu.edu) and indicate your intentions.

☐ Register for Courses

Registration for new transfers will take place from July 11, 2023 to August 11, 2023. To be eligible, we must have received your official transcript(s).

☐ Send Final Transcripts by Saturday, July 29, 2023

Send your official, final transcript(s), including grades for the Spring 2023 term, no later than July 29, 2023. Failure to submit your transcript(s) will result in your admission being withdrawn.

Send official test scores needed to fulfill admission requirements

If you have taken and passed AP, IB, or CLEP exams to satisfy any of the CSU admission requirements, request that your official scores be sent to SJSU.

Meet the CSU minimum requirements for upper division transfer admission

An internal review (verification) of your application will be conducted. Your official, final transcript(s) must show that you meet the CSU transfer admission requirements in order to pass final verification. To ensure that your provisional admission passes final verification, make sure your official, final transcript(s) meets the following criteria:

- You must have an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- You must be in good standing at the last college or university attended.
- You must meet the four basic skills course requirements with a grade of "C-" or higher by the end of the Spring 2023 term. A grade of "D+" or lower will not meet this requirement. SJSU will accept "Credit" or "Pass" for transferable college courses completed in Winter, Spring, Summer, or Fall 2020 terms and in Winter, Spring, or Summer 2021 terms to satisfy the four basic skills course requirements.
- You must complete at least 60 transferable semester (90 quarter) units by the end of the Spring 2023 term.

Be advised: If you have any outstanding documents such as official transcripts, that are past due at the time of registration, your eligibility to register will be delayed until they are received and processed (which can take up to two weeks).

■ Monitor MySJSU to avoid the cancelation of your admission

Failure to meet all deadlines will result in your admission being withdrawn. You can avoid your admission being withdrawn by carefully and frequently monitoring your MySJSU account (one.sjsu.edu) throughout the entire admission process.

Change of Major

A request to change your major from an online program to a regular session program is not permitted. You will need to cancel your application and reapply to the next available term. There are no exceptions to this policy.

Intent to Enroll

SJSU Online students do not need to submit an intent to enroll. Information about orientation resources will be sent in the coming weeks via email. There is no enrollment deposit required.
