Academic Requirements First-Time First Year (Freshmen)

Applicants will be eligible for admission consideration according to the following minimum GPA requirements (a-g coursework):

Nonresident of California: 3.0 or greater

Areas	Years Required
a. History/Social Science: One year of U.S. history or U.S. history and government	Two years
b. English: Composition and literature	Four years
c. Mathematics: Algebra, geometry, intermediate algebra; or integrated mathematics	Three years (four years recommended)
d. Laboratory Science: One year of biological science and one year of physical science; both with lab	Two years (three years recommended)
e. Language other than English: Study in the same language	Two years
f. Visual and Performing Arts: Select a year-long course from art, theatre/drama, music or dance	One year
g. Elective	One year

Applicants below these GPA minimum requirements will not be considered for admission at SJSU. Visit sjsu.edu/admissions for more information.

Upper Division Transfer

(applicants who will have earned 60 semester/90 quarter transferable units by the end of the Spring 2025 term)

You will be eligible to be reviewed for admission by SJSU if you meet the following criteria:

- Successfully complete the equivalent of 60 semester/90 quarter transferable units. SJSU does not accept applications from individuals seeking a second bachelor's degree; please consider applying to a graduate level program.
- Pass the four basic skills courses equivalent to those taken at a U.S. college or university with a grade of "C-" or better
 - A1 Oral Communication
 - A2 Written Composition (English)
 - A3 Critical Thinking (Logic)
 - B4 Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning (Intermediate Algebra as prerequisite)
- Earn a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or greater
- Be in good standing at the last institution you attended (for example, not disqualified).

How is residency determined for tuition purposes?

The determination of residency for tuition purposes affects whether a student pays in-state or out-of-state tuition fees. Out-of-state tuition fees are higher than in-state tuition fees. Certain requirements, established under California law, must be met. Fees Are Subject to Change

The CSU makes every effort to keep student costs to a minimum. Fees listed in published schedules or student accounts may need to be increased when public funding is inadequate. Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after fees are initially charged or initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees, other than mandatory systemwide fees, are subject to change without notice, until the date when instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as estimates that are subject to change upon approval by the Board of Trustees, the Chancellor, or the Presidents, as appropriate. Changes in mandatory systemwide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028 - 66028.6 of the Education Code).

Students should never pay Faculty members directly for any services or goods. All fees are mandatory with the exception of the Student Involvement and Representation Fee (SIRF) and are assigned a due date based on the date you register.
