The *University's Policy on Academic Integrity (Academic Senate Policy F06-1)* requires an annual report regarding the number and type of academic infractions reported and their disposition. In accordance with this requirement, please find the attached materials.

### **SUMMARY**

During the 2006/2007 academic year 195 reports of violations of the Academic Integrity Policy were filed with the Office of Student Conduct and Ethical Development. Sixty (60) were for incidents of cheating and the remaining one hundred thirty-five (135) were for plagiarism. The listings that follow delineate the cases according to the sanctions given and the origination of the case.






**Number of Reported Cases & Violations to the Academic Integrity Policy
