

VIOLATIONS TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY STATISICAL REPORT 2008-2009

Summary

During the 2008 -2009 academic year 246, reports of violations to the Academic Integrity Policy were filed with the Office of Student Conduct & Ethical Development. Ninety-one (91) were for incidents of cheating. The remaining one hundred fifty five (155) were for plagiarism.

The following two lists summarized the academic sanctions applied by the faculty for cheating & plagiarism.






Reported Cases of Violations to the Academic Integrity Policy 2008 - 09
