

VIOLATIONS TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY STATISTICAL REPORT 2009-2010

Summary

During the 2009-2010 academic year, 232 reports of violations to the Academic Integrity Policy were filed with the Office of Student Conduct & Ethical Development. Seventy seven (77) were for incidents of cheating. The remaining one hundred fifty five (155) were for plagiarism.

The following two lists summarized the academic sanctions applied by the faculty for cheating and plagiarism.






Reported Cases of Violations to the Academic Integrity Policy 2009-2010
