

VIOLATIONS TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY STATISTICAL REPORT 2011-2012

Summary

During the 2011-2012 academic year, 256 reports of violations to the Academic Integrity Policy were filed with the Office of Student Conduct & Ethical Development. Ninety three (93) were for incidents of cheating. The remaining one hundred sixty three (163) were for plagiarism.

The following two lists summarized the academic sanctions applied by the faculty for cheating and plagiarism.






Reported Cases of Violations to the Academic Integrity Policy 2009-2010
