

VIOLATIONS TO THE ACADEMIC INTEGRITY POLICY STATISTICAL REPORT 2012-2013

Summary

During the 2012-2013 academic year, 264 reports of violations to the Academic Integrity Policy were filed with the Office of Student Conduct & Ethical Development. Of the 264 reports, 111 were for incidents of cheating. The remaining 153 were for plagiarism.

The following two lists summarized the academic sanctions applied by the faculty for cheating and plagiarism.






Reported Cases of Violations of the Academic Integrity Policy 2012-2013
