


During the 2016-2017 academic year, **291 reports** were filed with Student Conduct and Ethical Development regarding violations of the Academic Integrity Policy. **Academic Dishonesty Reports for 2016-2017**







The values below are in comparison to the previous academic year.

- 21% decrease in overall number of AI cases
- 53% decrease in Copying from another (1.1.1)
- 25% increase in Submitting Previously Graded Work (1.1.2)
- 100% decrease in Submitting work simultaneously in two or more courses (1.1.3)
- 35% increase in Using Unauthorized Materials (1.1.4)
- No changes in Altering / Interfering with Grades (1.1.5)
- 33% increase in students using a surrogate (1.1.6)
- 49% decrease in cases where students misrepresent or aid others (1.1.7)
- 14% increase in cases where a Student represented work of another as their own (1.2.1)
- 200% increase in cases where a Student represented another’s scholarly work as their own. (1.2.2)


**Faculty (Academic) Sanctions Issued**

Chart revealing academic outcome for 15-16 AY, all colleges


